This is an interest free payment plan with payments per module. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is required at the time of application to reserve a seat in the program.

Upon commencement of the first module, student will pay for student materials kit, textbook kit, and Module One tuition (tuition reduced to reflect deposit). Loupes are NOT included and are the financial responsibility of the student.

To our knowledge there are no institutions providing financial aid for this type of program. We have broken down the tuition per module to make payments easier. We accept Mastercard, Visa, or American Express credit cards or money orders for tuition payment.
